2010 SPRING STAMPEDE RULES

Age of Horse: as of Jan. 1st, 2010

Age of Rider: as of Dec. 1st, 2009

Show is judged according to the **West Coast Horse Show Rulebook**. A copy will be at the show.

All persons, whether showing or not, must sign a release form and wear a wristband before riding on event grounds.

- ◆ English riders may ride Hunt Seat or Saddle Seat.
- ◆ Proper show attire is required, i.e. do not show a Western halter horse in English attire.
- ◆ All English riders must wear an ASTM approved hunt cap or helmet with the harness securely fastened when mounted anywhere on the show grounds, unless you are riding Saddle Seat. Helmets are acceptable for Western riders as well.
- ◆ Western Snaffle bits or Hackamores/Bosals to be used on horses 5 years of age and younger only. Riding two-handed is only allowed on horses 5 years and younger.
- ◆ Horses must be serviceably sound to compete.
- ◆ Competitors under 18 yrs. may not show colts or stallions.

Warm-Up/Training classes will not be judged; Gaits will be called. No points or awards.

Green Horses and Green Riders (any age) are in their first year of showing.

Lead Line – Rider 6 yrs. and under may enter Halter or Showmanship, but may not ride in any other division. Lead Liners must have lead ropes connected to halters that are either over or under the bridle. Lead Liners must have feet in stirrups. No handler under the age of 13 shall be allowed to lead in the Lead Line class. All Lead Line Handlers must sign a Release form.

10 & under Riders: May not enter any class requiring a lope or canter. If the rider has shown at the lope/canter previously, then he/she must enter the 17 & under classes.

18+ /AA (Adult Amateur): Persons 18 years of age and older who are not Trainers or who do not receive remuneration for lessons or training and who do not accept pay or prize money for showing Equitation or Showmanship.

Open Classes: Anyone of any age may show in the Open classes; Trainers may *only* show in the Open classes.

2- and 3-Gait Gaited Pleasure is for gaited horses only. Shown at the walk, intermediate gait and canter/lope.

Hobby Horse Rookie Rewards WJ Horsemanship Class Novice Not to have won more than 3 Blue ribbons in any riding class. No points. Ribbons 1st thru 5th. Class winner will receive \$100 gift certificate to Hobby Horse.

Awards: Prizes to 1st, Ribbons 1st - 6th, Points to 6th.

High Point of the Day points for one horse/rider combination. Any ties will be broken based on the most total firsts. If this does not break the tie, the next evaluation will be the most firsts in equitation, then by toss of a coin.

CSHA Members must hold membership in good standing to earn discounts and points. You may join CSHA at the show.

Judge's decision is final. Do not approach Judge with complaint. Management reserves the right to combine, split or cancel classes as necessary.

- ◆ Exhibitor number must be visible at all times. If number is on saddle pad, it must be visible on both sides. You must wear the number you are given. Switching of numbers or horses is grounds for disqualification.
- ◆ No selling from your trailer unless you hold a vendor's permit.
- ◆ Dogs must be on leashes and under control at all times.
- ◆ Children must be supervised at all times.
- ◆ Food and beverages will be available in Vendors' Alley.
- ◆ Please keep the show grounds clean. Pick up your trash, horse manure and hay. Do not put manure in garbage cans or leave on show grounds.
- ◆ It is the responsibility of each competitor to stay within the arena area to hear the announcements and keep track of his/her classes.
- ◆ A one-and-a-half-minute gate call will be enforced. No refunds for missed classes. For tack change, let the entry table or announcer know at least 3 classes before. Please use the in and out gates in a timely manner.

ADD / DROP Policy:

Please leave an OPEN CHECK with your entry form if you think you may add or drop any classes.

ADDS/DROPS: You must fill out an ADD/DROP card and pay your class fees before you leave the show or you will be billed.

NO REFUNDS – for any reason unless horse or rider is injured. Must submit a Vet's or Dr.'s certificate to Show Manager up to five days (postmarked date) after the show date.

No Rain Date: Show will go on in rain at management's discretion. All monies shall be refunded if show is canceled.
